### **BILLETING**

Your room assignment will be determined prior to In-processing and has been assigned with an effort to keep each work group together to facilitate team bonding. However, the final determination will be based on the mix of male-female students. Males and females may be in the same apartment, but will not be roomed together.

Billeting is in apartments as opposed to dormitory rooms. Each apartment building has four apartments; each apartment accommodates five to six people. There is a full kitchen in each apartment that includes a refrigerator, stove/oven, table and chairs, and plenty of counter and cabinet storage. Students housed together should work out the use of refrigerator space. Trash receptacles for bagged trash are available on the side of each apartment building.

Because all meals are provided, and students are expected to attend each meal, there should be very little, if any, need to use the cooking facilities. And because a kitchen is available, students may not keep coffee pots, hot plates, toaster ovens, etc., in their rooms. Ice trays, coffee makers, pots and pans, and dishes are not provided.

Each student is provided a desk with light, chair, chests of drawers, and bed with pillow. One set of linens (sheets, pillowcase, and blanket) is provided for the week. Both sheets are unfitted, so if you desire, you may bring a fitted sheet that fits a college-size twin bed. An extra pillow or blanket should be brought if you think you'll need either.

All rooms are heated and air-conditioned. There is one closet that is large enough to accommodate the number of students assigned to a given room (no more than two).

Each room has a telephone with an assigned McDaniel College extension, as well as an internet jack for each occupant. Students may not make long-distance calls from these telephones. See the "Internet" document for information on access.

Each apartment has two bathrooms which contain a shower and toilet. Two sinks and counter space are provided in the hallway of each apartment in a common area, i.e., not enclosed. Facilities are not available for housing spouses or other family members. Students will be extremely busy and need to devote their attentions to the work at hand.
